“BS Index” tool shows the Green Party opposite of Conservatives in more than just long-term thinking

Whitehorse—During the last two forums, audiences used an index card and sticky circles to make a statement about the level of honesty they perceived in the candidates. The Green Party’s John Streicker was at extreme end of “very honest”.

“I have served Yukoners in political life for years now, and I know how important it is to be honest and direct with people,” Streicker says. “I am seeking a lot of misinformation in this campaign,” Streicker says. “This was an opportunity to see what Yukoners themselves are seeing.”

One side of the meter states “Not sincere, up front. Didn’t answer in an open and honest fashion” whereas the other states “Very sincere, answering in an open and honest fashion.” The cards were collected from the youth forum on April 15, which ranked the candidates as follows:

Ryan Leef

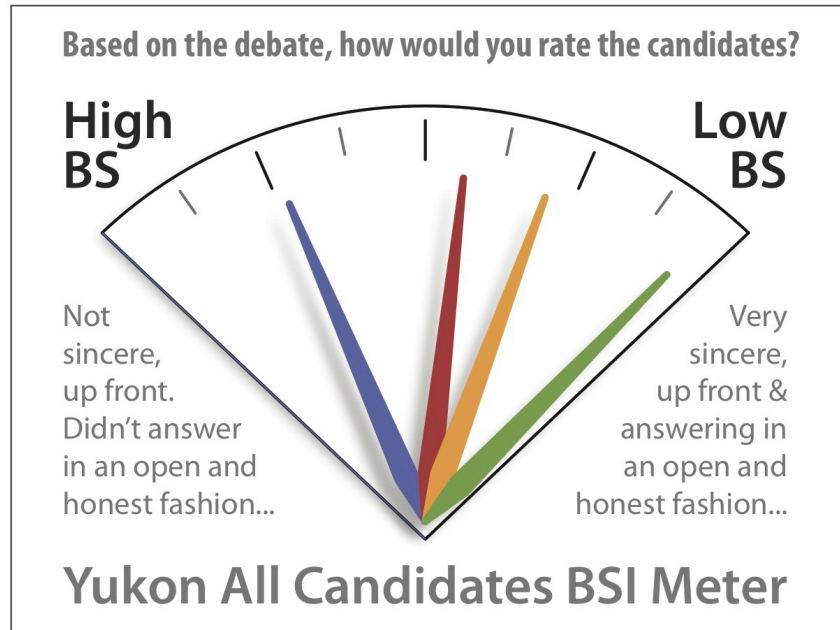
Streicker hopes that Yukoners will continue to reflect on the importance of choosing a representative who is working to keep democracy at the level of the people.
